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this 1986 book examines some of the main issues that have characterized macroeconomics the debate between monetarists and keynesians the response to demand shocks and supply shocks by which the monetary authorities control aggregate nominal income and the use and relevance of the money supply as a target and the consumption function and the determinants of wealth it shows that keynesian stabilization policies succeeded in reducing instability due to demand shocks dramatically but that no aggregate demand policy can stabilize both price and employment simultaneously after a supply shock however by assigning an overall social cost to excess unemployment and initially unexpected inflation an optimism path can be derived in looking at the consumption function and determinants of wealth the empirical evidence is shown to be most consistent with the life cycle hypothesis a concluding section is devoted to the impact on private and national society of the social security revolution

countries around the world are heatedly debating whether property should be a constitutional right but american lawyers have largely ignored this debate which is divided into two clear camps those who believe making property a constitutional right undermines democracy by fostering inequality and those who believe it provides the security necessary to make democracy possible in the global debate over constitutional property gregory alexander recasts this discussion arguing that both sides overlook a key problem that constitutional protection or lack thereof has little bearing on how a society actually treats property a society s traditions and culture alexander argues have a much greater effect on property rights laws must aim then to change cultural ideas of property rather than deem whether one has the right to own it ultimately alexander builds a strong case for improving american takings law by borrowing features from the laws of other countries particularly those laws based on the idea that owning property not only confers rights but also entails responsibilities to society as a whole

the debate over child care 1969 1990 offers a new perspective on the pervading problem of providing child care services in the united states the author traces the contemporary debate over the sponsorship of child care services and compares this to the past debate over the sponsorship of kindergartens during the progressive era klein compares the function of child care across societal sectors and points out that turf fighting and imbedded ideological differences have prohibited the development of a proactive social policy for providing needed child care services she analyzes the advantages and disadvantages of five different sponsors the public schools the church private enterprise non profit organizations and corporations past and present federal legislation is discussed in relation to the divisive issue of sponsorship

this is the first book to focus on occasionalism in early modern german philosophy it demonstrates that occasionalism provided a strong foundation for the thought of four important yet underexamined german philosophers erhard weigel johann christoph sturm christian wolff and gottfried ploucquet occasionalism is most often associated with cartesian early modern christian philosophers the most famous of whom is perhaps nicolas malebranche early modern german occasionalism has

received very little scholarly attention leaving us with an incomplete picture of the german causation debate from leibniz to kant this book combines a chronological investigation of four influential and historically connected cases of occasionalism in early modern germany with a reconstruction of arguments to address specific problems in metaphysics natural philosophy philosophy of language and philosophy of psychology providing a sufficient ground for nature and human beings mental and physical existence is a pressing issue for weigel sturm wolff and ploucquet in examining the thought of these four understudied german philosophers this book helps us rethink the relation between metaphysics of nature and science of nature and better understand the development of early modern debates about causation occasionalism and the debate about causation in early modern germany is an important resource for scholars and advanced students working on the history of early modern philosophy and the history of metaphysics and causation

this study is the first to critically survey the changing and highly controversial historical literature surrounding the american civil war era from contemporary interpretations up to the present the racial question was one of the central causes of the war there was recognition of the need for america to conform wholly to the declaration of independence that all men are created equal the book both analyzes historians attitudes and assumptions and suggests that each writer s perspective was partly determined by the dictates of time and place

g w f hegel s so called speculative logic was revolutionary since it attacked the basic laws of aristotelian logic the laws of contradiction and excluded middle which stood as the foundation for the field for well over a millennium hegel replaced these laws with the principle of mediation which he used to redefine all the key terms of the discipline in the 1830s this highly controversial theory was attacked by a number of philosophers in germany and prussia these debates spilled over into denmark in the late 1830s and early 1840s and represent one of the signal episodes in the danish hegel reception the present volume includes the main texts in this controversy the debate proper was initiated by the article rationalism supernaturalism by the theologian jakob peter mynster who attacked hegel s criticism of the law of excluded middle the poet johan ludvig heiberg and the young theologian hans lassen martensen then came to hegel s defense with articles which responded to

plays transgressed established norms but by the range of positions that were voiced on a given topic martin wagner investigates the roughly 1 000 plays from across europe that were introduced to the burgtheater s repertoire between 1814 and 1867 by combining a general overview with detailed interpretations of especially successful plays wagner reveals that the burgtheater was significantly more involved in contemporary debates than the stereotype of this stage as an artistically refined but apolitical institution suggests drawing from theatre studies and german and austrian studies more broadly a stage for debate revises the history of one of europe s leading theatres
